Resolution: Supporting Voluntary HIV Testing

WHEREAS:

The counseling and education which accompany HIV testing present

a unique opportunity to affect behavior change; and

WHEREAS:

rather than testing there are more appropriate and less costly

methods of educating those who are at little or no risk.

WHEREAS:

in the past bills have been introduced in the Arizona Legislature which do not have adequate provisions for counseling and

education services; and

WHEREAS:

testing in the absence of counseling and education hold minimal

preventive merits.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Arizona Public Health Association supports:

1. voluntary HIV testing accompanied by an adequate standard of counseling and education,

- 2. statutory/regulatory protection of confidentiality,
- improved access to free, confidential and anonymous testing services in rural areas of the state and under served urban neighborhoods.
