

RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Arizona Public Health Association believes that a Coordinating Council on Public Health should be established in the State of Arizona in order to facilitate the progress and work of Public Health in the state; therefore

Be it resolved by the 13th Annual Convention of the Arizona Public Health Association:

That the President of the Arizona Public Health Association or his duly appointed agent be the official representative of said Association on the proposed Coordinating in Public Health; and

That the President is directed to form or to assist in forming the Coordinating Council consisting of representatives from the several professional, civic, service, and religious groups, and any other organization interested in the subject of Public Health.
