ARIZONA PUBLIC HEALTH ASSOCIATION RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Clerical members of Public Health Associations have provided considerable input and continued support at both the Affiliate and National levels; and
- WHEREAS, This support and input has been generally unrecognized; and
- WHEREAS, Clerical and administrative support personnel are not generally recognized as having an identifiable role within the public health system; and
- WHEREAS, There has been considerable confusion at the Affilate level with the name "Secretarial Section" when in fact, the section is intended to include all clerical personnel as well as administrative aides and assistants
- BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Secretarial Section urge the members of the American Public Health Association to recognize support personnel by supporting the formation of an Administrative Support Section; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Affiliate organization extend this recognition to the national level by urging the American Public Health Association to recognize the establishment of an Administrative Support section within the American Public Health Association; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that program content at the National and Affiliate meetings include material relevant to administrative support personnel.
