It's a common-sense solution that'll moderate the partisanship that's been stifling progress on policy issues like school funding, voucher accountability, abortion care, affordable housing, water & environmental policy, and other important issues.

Proposition xxx will make general election races more competitive by giving independent & moderate voters more of a voice. It'll also make candidates more accountable to more voters & lead to better choices and better results and a stronger Arizona.
